What is Destination ImagiNation?

Destination ImagiNation is a non-profit, global, youth-centered, creative problem solving program, teaching life skills and expanding imaginations through team-based creative problem solving. Kindergarten through college age students work as a team to present one of five *Team Challenges* at tournaments which contain artistic, technical, performance and improvisational components. In addition, students will be given an *Instant Challenge* for which they will be scored on teamwork and quick creativity.

What is an Appraiser?

one who discovers and records every point each team earns, on a level playing field

We're looking for folks who can express what they appreciated in each and every solution, even for teams that have problems with their challenge.
